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# 1. AI for Small Business: What's Real and What's Hype

## What AI cannot do (yet)

- **Make strategic decisions for you** — AI can give you data and options, but the big calls about your business direction still need your judgment.
- **Work perfectly out of the box** — Every AI tool needs some setup and training to work well for your specific business. Anyone telling you otherwise is selling something.
- **Guarantee results without human oversight** — AI makes mistakes. It needs a human checking the important stuff, especially anything client-facing.

**The bottom line:** AI is not going to run your business for you. But it can genuinely save you 5–15 hours per week on tasks you probably don't enjoy doing anyway. That's time you can spend on the work that actually makes you money.

## 2. Five AI Tools Every Sydney Business Should Be Using

You don't need to spend thousands to start using AI. These five tools are either free or very affordable, and they'll make an immediate difference to how you work.

### 1. ChatGPT or Claude — Your AI Writing Assistant

**Cost:** Free (basic) / \$30–\$35 per month (pro)

Think of it as a very smart assistant who can draft emails, write social media posts, summarise documents, brainstorm ideas, and answer questions about almost anything. Use it to write your next client proposal in 10 minutes instead of an hour.

**Pro tip:** Be specific with your requests. Instead of 'write me a marketing email', try 'write a friendly follow-up email to a Sydney plumber who enquired about a new website last week but hasn't responded'. The more context you give, the better the output.

### 2. Otter.ai or Fireflies — Meeting Transcription

**Cost:** Free (limited) / \$10–\$20 per month

Records your meetings (in-person or video calls), transcribes them automatically, and generates a summary with action items. Never miss a detail from a client conversation again.

**Pro tip:** Use it for every client call. After the meeting, you'll have a searchable record of exactly what was discussed and agreed. Great for avoiding the 'but I thought we said...' conversations.

### 3. Calendly or Cal.com — AI-Powered Scheduling

**Cost:** Free (basic) / \$12 per month

Let clients book meetings directly into your calendar without the back-and-forth emails. Set your availability, share the link, done. It even sends automatic reminders so people actually show up.

**Pro tip:** Put your booking link in your email signature, on your website, and on your Google Business profile. The easier you make it to book, the more enquiries convert into meetings.

### 4. Zapier or Make — Workflow Automation

**Cost:** Free (limited) / \$25–\$75 per month

Connects your apps together so things happen automatically. For example: new form submission on your website → automatically creates a contact in your CRM → sends a welcome email → notifies you on Slack. No coding required.

**Pro tip:** Start with one automation that saves you the most time. For most service businesses, that's automating what happens after someone enquires — the follow-up sequence. A quick response wins the job.

## 5. Thanksm8 — Automated Google Review Collection

**Cost:** \$49 per month

Using your email provider (Gmail, Outlook) or a free Zapier account, set up one automated follow-up. For example: when someone fills out your contact form, automatically send a thank-you email with your booking link. Simple but effective.

### **Friday: Ask for reviews (10 minutes)**

Text or email your five most recent happy customers and ask them to leave a Google review. Include a direct link to your review page. Most people are happy to help — they just need to be asked. (Or set up Thanksm8 and never think about it again.)
